

North Chapel No 3, The Painting Saint Rose of Lima

The painting Saint Rose of Lima, shows the miracle of a still-born child who was brought back to life on the 5th of January 1669. His father had been more concerned about the loss of his child's soul than his life, and believed that Saint Rose (1586 – 1617) had intervened. She has since been specially honoured in this church. The documents regarding the resuscitation are kept in the archives of Buis les Baronnie. The altar, steps and tabernacle date from the 19th Century; they were listed in 1974.
