

Refectory

This former refectory of the Dominicans, or Preacher Brothers, is in the south-eastern part of the abbey. After the French Revolution it was used for minor duties of the Justices of the Peace.

The room has walnut panelling as well as two cupboards decorated with intricate marquetry, notably on the doors. These date from the first half of the 18th century (listed in 1974 and restored in 2007 with aid from the Conseil Général of the Drôme).
